Russell Carroll's Family Farm - History of Merchant Sweets Oswego River Farm

Buying the Oswego River Home -The farm was purchased from L. Doris Wood in Aug 1945 by Russell Carroll for immediate possession as reported in the Oswego Palladium¹, see Figure 1 and recorded in Index of Deeds². This included a large tract of land bordering the old canal and extending north-east to route 57. Approximately 100 acres as shown on the map see Figure 2. The property is just off the right of Walter Island and on earlier maps is defined as tract 94 in Schroeppel Township situated about 2 miles from Phoenix, NY on the Oswego River Road. Russell does move into this old farm home immediately but this is a very old home showing its age with none of the conveniences of the prior Cortland home - a definite hardship.
