Chapter One

Lodica *Herring* Farnham (1863-1951)

In 1990 Grace Carroll the granddaughter of Lodica Farnham (Figure 1) was asked by her 12 year old granddaughter Denise Carroll, "Do you remember any interesting stories about your ancestors and is there any part of our family's past that you are especially proud of?" Grace responded¹ "I do not know where my dad's family came from, but I do know my Grandmother Lodica's father came from Germany his last name was Herring and he was an early settler in Michigan. He was a tailor, but in this country he was a pioneer and farmer. I know that the life was hard. There were Indians, and wolves and bears around. My grandmother tells about digging out bear dens and killing the bears and clubs. Also about wolves and wild dogs who killed sheep and farm animals. She also told me about her oxen that she raised and drove. Her mother died when she was 12 or 13 and she had to take over the household chores. She also knew how to make salves and medication out of herbs and wild growing plants. I am proud of my grandmother who knew all of these things and was a hard worker who raised 4 children out of 8."

Lodica was born September 8, 1863 in Toronto, Canada² ³ ⁴. Lodica's parents are John Herring and Harriet Mehitable Farnham. Harriet Farnham was the daughter of Isaac Farnham⁵ a farmer who lived in Otisco, New York. A will probate⁶ of Isaac establishes the
